Function and play:

Team assembly and construction plant. On a long, slow-moving electric conveyor, letters made of soft rubber cutting. Builders stand on the sides of the conveyor. They try to find the missing letters that match the pattern of the word to complete. In the end side letters fall into a pickup circle. With the help of buckets, the letters poured to the start of the conveyor belt movement. It is possible to empty the word templates into the conveyor belt at the end of the assembly play.

technical information:

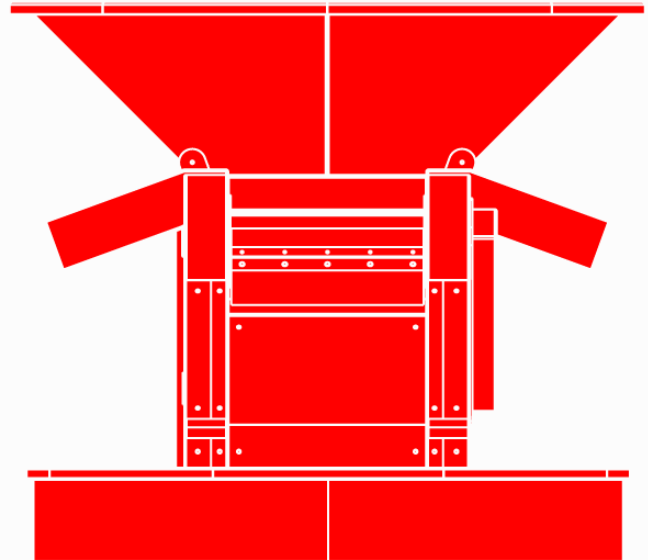
316 stainless steel structure. Wooden cladding parts. An internal conveyor belt powered by an electric motor. Interior lighting throughout the whole structure. Requires a 24V power supply. Switchable and silent during rest hours.

Foundations:

A self-stabilizing structure.

Soundvoice:

Optional – A sequence of recordings of know A musical tunes, full with rhythm and movement, Play on internal speakers while operating the conveyor belt.

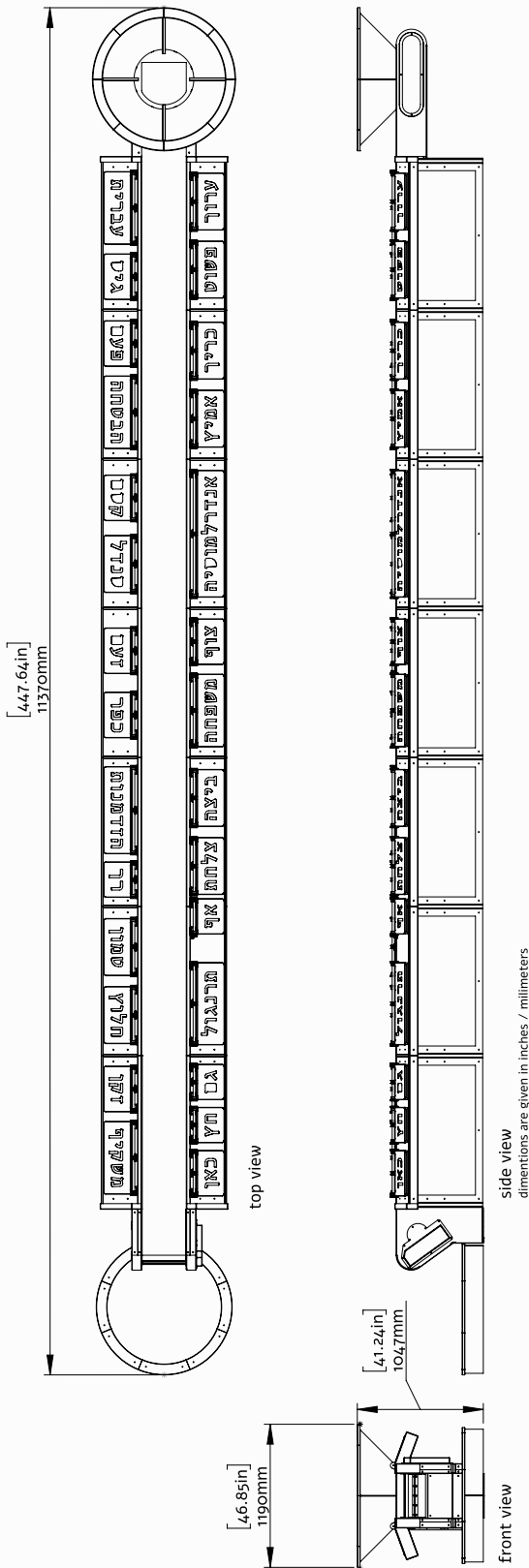
