Chromatic tapper

Function and play:

A climbing net is surrounding a tapper helix. It is possible to climb the net from different directions and sit on the main tube and press the calibrated keys connected to each of the main pillars of the structure, playing a chromatic scale of one octave, together or alone.

Technical information:

316 stainless steel structure, climbing net, calibrated musical parts.

Surfacing requirements:

Corresponds to a fall height of
≤ 2845mm / 112 inches

Foundations:

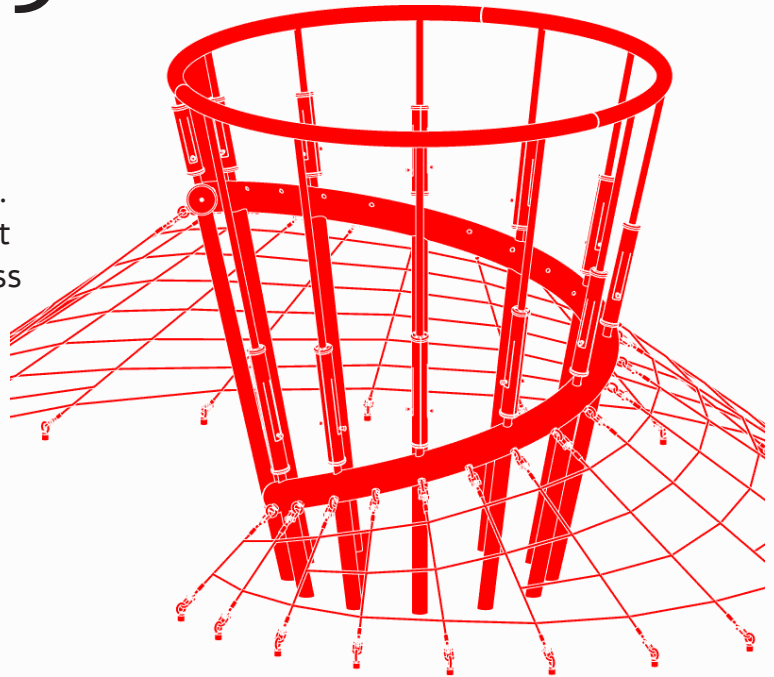
Reinforced wide strip concrete
L7000 x W7000 x 200mm depth

Total excavation depth:

400 mm, including a gravel bed underneath reinforced concrete. Deeper excavation in the center.

Sound voice:

The sound of pressing metal bars calibrated into one chromatic octave.

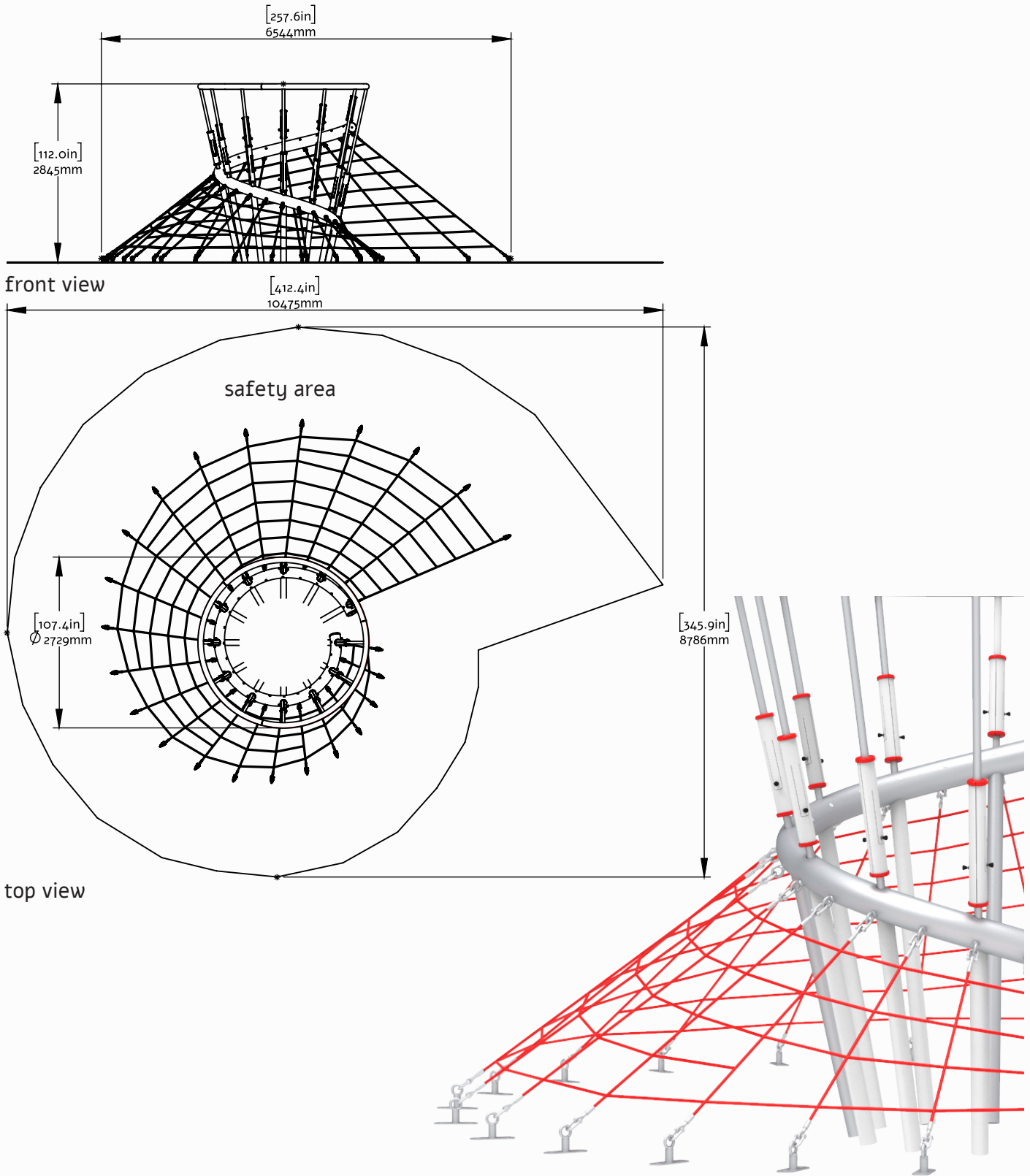
